



June 7th Meeting Minutes

Attendance: Michael Knudson, Fair Stirman, Paul Terjeson, Kelli Terjeson, Melissa La Crosse, Jessica Baxter, Liz Jones, Jenni Hastings, Steve Hastings and Shaw Germond.

Treasurer Report: Fair reported that there is \$2,000.00 in the carnival account and \$10,909.62 in the PTC account with \$3,340.13 encumbered (\$3,000 due for Journey books the PTC agreed to pay \$6,700 for at the beginning of the year and currently owes a balance of \$3,000.).

Jefferson School Bond (Paul): Paul Terjeson was present in support of the PTC and asked for feedback on the school bond. He invited everyone to attend the facilities meeting on Tuesday at 7pm.

Burgerville: On May 23rd we held our Burgerville partnership and raised \$458.00 and just over \$60.00 in tips. This year we did two events, one in the Fall and one in the Spring – it was decided that we would continue with two events next school year.

Reader board: PTC voted and agreed to buy the board for \$50 in April. It cost \$27.75 to rekey and the PTC voted to fund the cost of rekeying and reimburse Shaw. Fair will forward the receipt for processing.

Box Tops: This last collection brought in just over 5100 tops and we rewarded five classrooms with ice cream treats and the teachers with coffee cards. Thank you Emily for collecting, counting and passing out the cards. Mindi passed out the tasty treats.

Cookie Dough Fundraiser: It was agreed that we would continue to do this in the spring and perhaps add a couple more items to the selection. This particular fundraiser is locally owned and provides the largest profit and has great customer service.

Field Day: Field Day was a success with many volunteers. PTC provided orange dreamsicles which we purchased through the school food program.

Walk-a-thon: The walk-a-thon was May 27th. PTC provided water bottles. A little over \$1200.00 was raised this year.

5th grade promotion: The PTC donated \$100 towards this event.

Day of the week for meetings next year: Meetings next year will be the second Tuesday of each month for the 2016/17 school year.

S.M.A.R.T: JES was approved for SMART beginning next year. Katie will be heading it up for our school. The program requires background checks both at the school and with SMART. Volunteers are needed – please email Fair if you are interested.

3rd grade dictionaries and 2nd grade wordbooks (Jessica): Jessica was approached by a couple of teachers inquiring about the PTC funding dictionaries and wordbooks for next year. The PTC has funded this the last two years and it was voted on and passed for this coming year as well. Kaye Jones has volunteered her time in the past to teach all the 3rd graders how to use a dictionary and this year volunteered to buy a case of dictionaries as well. The cost will be around \$400.00 for all books. Fair will work with the District to make sure the purchases are made at the beginning of the year and to purchase enough for transferring students throughout the year.

Field Trip Accounts: The PTC voted to fund all classrooms with \$250.00 each for field trips next year. Fair inquired about the balance in the account and Mr. Knudson noted that there was over \$4,000.00 in the account. In years past, the PTC has continued to fund each classroom with \$250.00 and when classrooms did not use all the funds, they rolled over into the account for next year. This year the PTC voted and decided we would fund up to \$250.00 in each account (which is currently in there) and take additional requests as we traditionally do throughout the year.

Supply funds: The PTC will provide \$40.00 gift cards for supplies for all teachers including Mr. Naugle, Mr. Lake and the resource teacher in the Fall and again in the Spring. Fair will email the teachers in late summer to inquire about the desired store for supplies.

Concessions: The last concert we grossed \$94.00. Going into next year Fair brought up the idea of having more petty cash as \$40.00 is not enough – PTC voted and agreed on \$100.00 (half in \$1 bills and half in \$5 bills). PTC council will ensure the correct bills are in the petty cash box and supply concessions and round up volunteers.

Social Media (Jenni): Jenni Hastings presented to the PTC the idea about having a Facebook page for PTC. She had examples of other successful parent club pages in the valley. This would be a private page that would be maintained by the PTC council. Those in attendance were in favor of the idea. Emily will work with Jenni in setting up the page and the PTC will maintain the admin rights, it will be a private page and we will announce it at the first meeting next year. This will be a great way to get the news out about events, volunteer activities and meeting reminders. Thanks Jenni. 😊
