

# PTC Meeting Minutes

## April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2014

**Treasurer Report:** Around \$14,000.00 in PTC account.

- **Cookie dough / flower fundraiser:** Cookie dough orders were a great success! We brought in \$21,672.00 – the PTC will receive around 40% of that. 182 kids participated, 13 kids sold over \$300.00 worth of merchandise and the highest class had 20 kids participate! Special thank you to all the volunteers who assisted with over 50 man hours. ☺
- **Concessions deposit:** Thank you to Melissa for coordinating the volunteers in the concessions and for purchasing items to sell. Our last Concert night was a great success selling around \$230.00 worth of concessions.
- **Rainy day recess and PE supplies:** Staff have requested \$467.08 for rainy day recess and PE supplies – PTC voted and agreed.
- **Chairs and carts:** Currently all three school share chairs for events. The maintenance employees round up the chairs and deliver them before each event and then return them to their location. Some of the chairs have missing end caps on the bottom of the chair legs which could potentially damage the gym floor. The cost for 300 chairs and 4 racks to store them is \$3,758.60. The PTC voted and agreed to fund this need.

**Cub Pride gear:** \$1100.00 in sales – around 45 kids placed orders. All items have been delivered. Comments were made about how great it is to work with JoAnn and she is always willing to change items at the last minute or take late orders.

**Headstart report:** They are working on popcorn Friday in May with JES. Currently they are working on their end of year field trips to a local stable and a party at the park.

**Box Tops drive:** The next drive will be starting soon and the final day to have Box Tops in is the last Friday in May. The winning class for the last drive was Mrs. Russell's class ... they opted for root beer floats. Five other classes shared the second place slot and enjoyed ice cream sandwiches – Rushing, Thompson, Baez, Spell and Bean.

**Spring Break free lunches:** Free lunches were provided at the Library – Shaw enjoyed volunteering the entire week. The average was about 40 kids a day.

**Math Night Volunteer:** Brittany Russell asked for parents volunteer's for Math Night – Fair volunteered to run a table. This year's theme is Monopoly.

**Escrip & Fred Meyer Rewards:** Melissa signed up JES for this program – flyers will be going out soon. Our program number is 81462.

**Classified Appreciation week:** Fair will work with Susie and Kathy coordinating a day for the PTC to host a lunch. Fair will work on a couple of tangible gift ideas for the teachers. Shelley will work on a Costco PO for Fair to use for the PTC hosted lunch.

**School Lunch Hero Day – May 2<sup>nd</sup>:** A day set aside to celebrate our great lunch staff! Sara and Fair will work together and make it a special day for the four ladies that we have.

**Spring Book Fair:** May 5<sup>th</sup> – May 9<sup>th</sup> is the 50% of Book Fair. Ashley passed around a signup sheet for volunteers. The class with the highest contributions for “All for books” will win a pizza party.

**Jefferson Proud:** Kent provided a brief overview of Jefferson Proud – the start-up cost would be around \$28,000.00 and he is anticipating on requesting \$12,000.00 from the School Board and the remainder from Community Partners like PTC. He requested \$500.00 from the JES PTC. Marilyn headed up the voting on the \$500.00 and it passed.

*\*\*\* Please note that on April 14<sup>th</sup>, the School Board closed the door on Jefferson Proud. PTC funds will not go into this collaboration project.*

**Teacher support:** Following the Jefferson Proud vote, Fair suggested that the PTC match that amount and provide it to the teachers to assist in the classroom. Funds donated would help with end of year classroom expenses that there is no longer a budget for. Marilyn suggested we wait for Shelley to vote on that. Shelley returned and the group voted and unanimously agreed on \$50.00 gift cards for the certified staff. Shelley will coordinate getting those out to teachers.
