

PTC Meeting notes for Nov. 10, 2015

- Treasurer report- \$2000 in carnival fund and \$2100 in PTC fund. We are waiting for approx. \$610 from the Burgerville fundraiser to come in and we have approx. \$510 coming from Box Tops.
- Fred Meyer rewards- \$49 and don't forget to connect your Fred Meyers card to our school JES Jefferson, OR.
- Thanksgiving dinners- PTC will be donating Thanksgiving dinners to 4 families (Kathy and Susie will select the families). We agreed to spend \$50 per family and the shopping will be done at Winco.
- Super Self Manager Day- will be held on Wed. Nov. 25. The kids will be making apple turkeys - the apples are being donated by Greens Bridge Gardens. PTC will provide \$200 towards the craft and snacks.
- Christmas Crafts- we decided not to sell from Penguin Patch. Teachers can come to the PTC with a need towards their Holiday craft project.
- Staff Gifts- Feedback was that teachers appreciated the teacher gift of caramel apples and apple cider donated from Greens Bridge Gardens
- Staff dinner for conferences recap- A potato bar was the theme for conference dinner and feedback was that teachers appreciated and loved it.
- SLP needs- SLP submitted a list of things that were needed in the classroom - a sign up sheet was sent around for us to sign up to donate various items. Donations can be taken to the office and requested to be delivered to SLP or taken directly to SLP room.
- Fall Book Fair Review- Ashley was not at the meeting.
- Cub Pride gear- The winning design (PTC voted from 2 options) was sold through an online No Dinx spirit store. No Dinx (an Albany company who does a lot of work with local teams and groups) created the designs and managed the online store. Not as many items sold as in past years. We discussed this and there were various reasons we came up with – the bottom line is we will do a spring order and do a better job of reminders and advertising it.
- Shelley bought extra kids size shirts to be donated to students who want a shirt but have no means of getting his/her own shirt.
- Buddy Bench- the buddy bench is finished and installed but we are still waiting on the art work for the wall above the buddy bench to be completed by the High School Art Club.
- Concessions update-Shaw & Heather- We will only do some shopping at Costco but will do bulk of shopping at Cash & Carry. A lock will be put onto the concessions cupboard so it can be kept stocked without risk of loss. There was a question on what foods can be served with or without a permit? We believe anything advertised to the public such as movie night means a permit is required. Any event just for our school

such as concerts or square dance means no permit is required. Concessions will start keeping a notebook of what is purchased and how much is spent for future PTC to work off of. The After School Program has asked to use the popcorn machine and we agreed. The popcorn machine needs to be securely attached to its base and instructions will be attached to the machine of instructions on use and how to properly clean the machine.

- Tooth Taxi- We are on the waiting list for the Tooth Taxi
- Burgerville recap- \$3400 was sold during our Burgerville partner night. Between our 15% and the tip jar, the PTC will receive approx. \$610. Top attending classes were Mrs. Engberg, Mr. Cook and Mrs. Thompson. 1st place (Engberg) received a free milk shake gift card and 2nd place (Cook and Thompson) received blueberry muffins.
- Box Tops- The fall contest brought in about 5,100 Box Tops. This was a little less than we usually bring in during the fall. However, JMS is now collecting Box Tops and we believe that is why it was less. Top collecting classes (Frazier, Gokee, Cook, Engberg and Withee) will receive frozen treats for their class and teachers will get a \$10 gift card to the Jefferson Coffee Stop. Fair suggested a grand prize for top collecting classes for the entire year.
- Backpacks recap- Kids have been coming up and thanking Shelley/PTC for their backpacks. One teacher is using the backpacks to send home reading homework. It is nice to see them being utilized.
